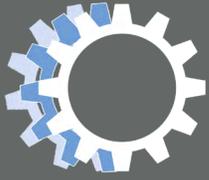


### EXAMPLE POSTSECONDARY GOALS

Use this list of 25 examples of high-quality measurable postsecondary goals as you develop goals for your students. This list includes a mixture of education/training, employment, and independent living/community involvement goals.

1. After graduation, Paul will enroll in a computer training course at the local community college to obtain a certificate of completion.
2. Upon leaving high school, Kim will work for 10 hours a week as a busser at a restaurant.
3. After high school, James will participate in an intramural sports team at the local recreation center for 5 hours per week.
4. Upon graduating high school, Michaela will attend a 4-year university to obtain a degree in biology.
5. Upon completion of high school, Jose will obtain a job working in retail for at least 15 hours per week, and will eventually take on more hours to be a full-time employee.
6. After leaving high school, Laura will complete a food safety course at the restaurant where she is employed.
7. After high school graduation, Clark will live in an apartment with a roommate and will independently complete chores such as cleaning and cooking.
8. Upon completion of high school, Janet will work part-time as an assistant at a daycare.
9. After high school, Marcus will obtain his driver's license by completing a driver's education course.
10. Upon graduating high school, Brittany will attend a 2-year postsecondary education program.
11. After graduation, Devonte will work part-time as a gym assistant for 15-25 hours per week.
