Ryan is a student in an inclusive higher education program. He is approved to have a notetaker if he needs one, so he goes to the disability services office to arrange this accommodation.



Requirement	Accommodation

Amanda is a student at a 2-year community college. Her professor explained to the class that there will be four multiple choice exams throughout the semester. Amanda's disability causes her to struggle with reading. She does much better on tests when it is read to her.



Requirement	Accommodation

Jennifer is in a career training program to become a certified veterinary assistant. The training course she's in requires her to stand for long periods of time, but Jennifer has a disability that makes standing challenging. She decides to tell the instructor that she will need a stool available for when she needs to sit down.



Requirement	Accommodation

Justin just started school at a 4-year university and is getting a degree in business. Due to his visual impairment, Justin has a service dog that assists him in getting around campus. He also benefits from text-to-speech software so that he can study his professor's presentations before class.



Requirement	Accommodation

Samantha just started school at a 2-year community college and is taking classes part time. One of Samantha's strengths is participating in group discussions, but she will need a sign language interpreter to communicate. Her professor instructs her to talk to the disability services office so that an interpreter can be provided for her.



Requirement	Accommodation

Anthony is taking courses at a vocational training school to be a certified mechanic. One of Anthony's courses requires him to perform a series of repairs on a car. Anthony's disability causes him to struggle with remembering the tasks in order. His teacher gives him a written list of the steps so that Anthony can practice repairs more efficiently.



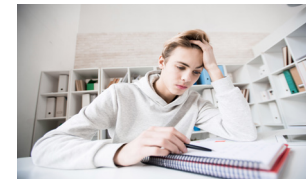
Requirement	Accommodation

Jasmine is a student at a 4-year university and wants to study art. Jasmine uses a wheelchair, so she wants to make sure that the art studios are all accessible. She decides to disclose her disability to disability services to request that all of the art classrooms have ramps if needed and that she will be able to pull her chair up to her workspaces without difficulty.



Requirement	Accommodation

Nathan is a student at a 2-year junior college. He loves learning but tends to get distracted and struggles with focusing during long tests. Nathan talks with his professor and the office of disability services so that he can take tests in a quiet setting with extended time.



Requirement	Accommodation

Abby is a student in an inclusive higher education program. Abby takes a medication that makes her drowsy in the afternoons. Because of this, Abby needs her classes to be before 12:00. She went to the office of disability services and requested priority class registration to ensure she gets classes in the morning.



Requirement	Accommodation

Chris is getting a certificate in computer science at a vocational training school. Chris has a visual impairment which makes a traditional computer keyboard difficult to use. He decides to ask for an adapted keyboard with large letter keys so that he is able to complete his assignments.



Requirement	Accommodation

Have the exam read to her

Stand for long periods of time

Stool to sit on as needed
