

**Instructions: Read the scenario and select the best answer.**

1. Brooke is a senior in high school and wants to apply to a 4-year university. One of the application requirements is to submit two letters of recommendation. She wants her math teacher and her manager at her job to write them because they know her personally and can give examples of how hard she works.



What should Brooke do?

5. Mckenna wants to apply to her local College of Applied Technology to get a certificate in Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning. She knows she will need some financial assistance to pay for the program. After doing some research, she finds that the program offers several scholarships.

What does receiving a scholarship mean for Mckenna?

Who should Naya contact at each program?

- Disability Services Office

10. Ruben knows that he needs a professional certificate in Early Childhood Education to get a job as a Teacher's Assistant. He does not want to be in school longer than 1 year. He wants to make sure that he is choosing a training program that can help him achieve this goal. While preparing, he found that a community college would require him to go for 2 years while a College of Applied Technology has the program he wants and only takes 12 months.
