2. Elijah's Individualized Plan for Employment (IPE) is created and signed. One of his responsibilities is to contact his VR counselor monthly. Elijah has an in-person meeting scheduled today, but he is not feeling well. What should he do?

Send his VR counselor an email and ask if he can reschedule

Cancel his meeting



3. Paola shared with her VR counselor that she likes working with animals, and she also enjoyed her internship at the library. Paola would like to learn more about jobs that are available. Who can best help her explore jobs in both career fields?

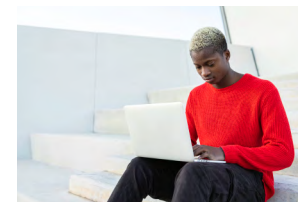
Paola's VR counselor can help her explore these career fields

4. Kaden applied for VR services. He is waiting for VR to contact him to let him know if he is eligible for services. How long will Kaden have to wait to get an answer?

- 7 days

5. Raquel has her first meeting with her VR counselor. Raquel has the right to include anyone she wants at these meetings. Since it is the first one, she decides to bring her mom. What is the role of someone who is supporting Raquel at these meetings?

- To make all the decisions for Raquel
- To listen and support Raquel during the meeting



6. Brenda has been working at her job for three months. She feels like she has a good relationship with her supervisor and co-workers. Brenda doesn't feel like she needs support from VR anymore. How can Brenda stop her VR services?

- As a VR client, Brenda can talk with her counselor about successfully closing her case
- Stop showing up to her VR meetings



7. Austin is meeting with his VR counselor who provides him with his eligibility letter. The print of the letter is regular-sized and too small for him to see. It would help if Austin had large print to read the information. What should he do?

- Do not ask for large print He can have someone read it to him later
- Tell his VR counselor that he needs large print as an accommodation



8. Jena receives an email stating that her VR application has been reviewed and she is not eligible for VR services. Jena talks with her school counselor, and she thinks she meets the eligibility guidelines. What steps can Jena take?

- Appeal the decision with the help of the Client Assistance Program (CAP)
- Accept the decision that she is not eligible for services



9. Tim likes his job but realizes he can get a promotion and make more money by earning a certificate as an Automotive Service Technician. Who can best help Tim explore colleges and training programs where he can earn an Automotive Service Technician certificate?

- Tim's VR counselor
- The bus driver





10. Leah is working with her VR counselor on developing her Individualized Plan for Employment – also called an IPE. Leah wants to find a job that she enjoys and that matches her work skills. What should Leah be discussing with her VR counselor to make sure the job she gets is a good

- The uniform Leah will have to wear for a job
- Her strengths, interests, and any education or training she will need
