1. Alyson has worked with her school counselor to apply to college. She is planning to apply for accommodations with the office of disability services. What type of resource is the office of disability services?

- Education resource
- Independent living resource



2. John just started his first semester at a local Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT). John has classes in different buildings around campus. How can John use his community resource map to find the buildings?

- Look for nearby coffee shops
- Use Google My Maps to pin the class buildings



3. Blake is working to create a community resource map. Blake has found many resources to add to her Google My Map. Blake adds her community club to her map. What type of resource is a community club?

- Recreation
- Employment



4. Brad attended a transition fair at his high school. He met with his local inclusive higher education program. Brad plans to apply to the program. What type of resource is an inclusive higher education program?

- Advocacy and disability rights resource
- Education resource



5. Sierra starts taking classes at her local community college in September. Sierra is excited to start college but is having trouble remembering how to get to campus. What should Sierra do?

- Call her professor and ask for directions 15 minutes before her class starts
- Use her community resource map to save the best route to get to campus



6. Matt understands directions best when he can listen to them. What type of map may be helpful for him?

- Audio recording
- Picture collage



7. Beth plans to move into a dorm this fall when she starts college. Beth is going to add the dorm to her Google My Map community resource map. Which layer should Beth add the dorm to?

- Independent living layer
- Recreation layer



8. Steve and Mike decide that they will work together to create their maps. Mike says they should use all the same resources for their maps, but Steve doesn't have the same college interests as Mike. What should Steve do?

- Create the exact same map as Mike
- Create maps that meet their individual needs



9. Jenny met with staff from the admission office and the office of disability services during a college tour. Jenny wants to add them to her community resource map. What information should Jenny include on her map?

- Their name and the best way to contact them
- The office name only





10. Andy is going to continue his education after high school. Andy is looking at four different colleges. How can including these on his community resource map help him make a decision?

- Add and pick the closest college to where he lives
- Add all four colleges on his map and include any resources that can support him at the school
