Agency



Organizations that provide specific services and supports to people

Apprenticeship



A program where you are paid to complete classroom instruction and hands-on training from someone who is already doing the job

Career and Technical Education(CTE)



A high school program that includes classes that teach technical skills that prepares students for specific careers

Full-time employment



A job that requires working 30-40 hours a week and usually comes with benefits such as health insurance and paid time off

High Demand



Jobs that are needed or have many opportunities or openings

Part-time employment



A job that requires an employee to work less than 35 hours a week and pays employees by the hour (usually 5-25 hours a week)

Resume



A document that summarizes a person's education, work experience, and skills

Seasonal employment



A job a person only works during the busy season for the business

Soft Skills



Personal attributes that allow a person to succeed in work or education (for example: communication, problem-solving, and work ethic)

Technical Skills



Abilities or knowledge used to perform specific tasks
