Pre-employment transition services (or Pre-ETS) is a program that helps students with disabilities prepare for life after high school. Pre-ETS are provided to students between ages 14-22. This program is a partnership between high schools and the Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) program.

JOB EXPLORATION COUNSELING

- Explore and discuss career interests.
- Learn in-demand job opportunities.

WORK BASED LEARNING

- Receive hands-on work experiences
- Learn about a variety of career paths
- Develop positive work habits and attitudes
- Understand supports and accommodations available in job settings

POST- SECONDARY EDUCATION COUNSELING

- Explore college and training programs
- Visit post-secondary education campuses
- Discuss disability services available on campus

WORKPLACE READINESS TRAINING

- Build necessary skills for future jobs
- Understand workplace expectations
- Improve workplace social and communication skills
- Identify assistive technology

INSTRUCTION IN SELF-ADVOCACY

- Learn how to understand their disability
- Identify legal rights and protections for people with disabilities
- Develop leadership skills
- Learn to advocate for own needs and accommodations

- Must be at least 14 years old
- Must be enrolled in a secondary educational program
- Does not need to be a Vocational Rehabilitation client to receive services
