SUMMARY

- Opportunity to learn about how to MANAGE AND SAVE MONEY.
 - ☐ Students can put money into **ABLE OR ROTH IRA ACCOUNTS.**
- □ OPPORTUNITY FOR JOB EXPLORATION.
 - ☐ Students learn what SUPPORTS they need on a job site as well as SKILLS they have.
- ☐ Allows students to LEARN WHAT ACCOMMODATIONS THEY NEED.
- ☐ Opportunity for students **TO SET GOALS.**
- ☐ Start JOB SEARCHING IN APRIL OR MAY.
- ☐ Practice INTERVIEW SKILLS with students.
 - ☐ Practice with family members, peers, or in front of a mirror.
- Teach students to **NETWORK** by asking questions about the business, introducing themselves, and maintaining conversations.
 - ☐ Teach students to **ASK FOR OPPORTUNTIES.**
- DEVELOP A RESUME for each student.
 - ☐ Look at our <u>sample résumé</u> for an example.
- □ ATTEND CHAMBER OF COMMERCE meetings with students to learn about future jobs.
- ☐ Help students navigate job posting websites.
