Upon graduation, Megan will live in her parent's house and gradually take on more responsibilities until she is prepared to move into her own apartment.

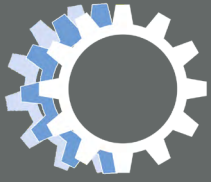
