 - Introduction to Self-Advocacy (7th-12th grade)
 - Focus on Adulthood Course (9th-12th grade)
 - Planning for Post-Secondary (11th-12th grade)
- ❑ Who are they for?
 - All special education endorsed teachers can teach these courses
 - Middle school and high school students with disabilities on an IEP (not 504 plan)
- ❑ The teacher of record for all three of the Principles of Transition courses must be properly endorsed with a special education endorsement. The following endorsement codes are listed in the approved endorsement list:
 - (069) Multiple Disabilities K-12
 - (105) Special Education K-12
 - (144) Interventionist K-8
 - (145) Interventionist 6-12
 - (190) Provisional Interventionist K-8
 - (191) Provisional Interventionist 6-12
 - (194) Provisional Special Education Modified K-12
 - (195) Provisional Special Education Comprehensive K-12
 - (196) Provisional Special Education Vision K-12
 - (197) Provisional Special Education Hearing PreK-12
 - (460) Special Education Modified K-12
 - (461) Special Education Comprehensive K-12
 - (462) Special Education Vision PreK-12
 - (463) Special Education Hearing PreK-12
 - (465) Special Education Early Childhood PreK-1
